VI. ADJOURNMENT:

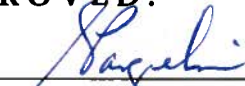
Upon a motion made by Commissioner Pangelinan and seconded by Commissioner Hongyee. The Commissioners adjourned approximately around 6:27pm.
