DECISION AND JUDGMENT

This matter came on to be heard the 28th day of February, 2019, for the presentation of the Post Audit Staff Investigation Report. Present for the hearing were Daniel Del Priore, representing 6 police officers and Jasen Dodd, Employees; Lt. Ronald Taitano representing the Guam Police Department (GPD) and GPD Chief Steven Ignacio; Cynthia KM Camacho, Personnel Management Analyst II, and Roland P. Fejarang, Personnel Management Administrator.

Staff read the report into the record. Employee representative, Daniel Del Priore, moved to continue the matter to allow the 6 police officers to be interviewed by the Personnel Management Analyst. The Commission discussed the matter and decided further interviews were unnecessary and voted 6-0


