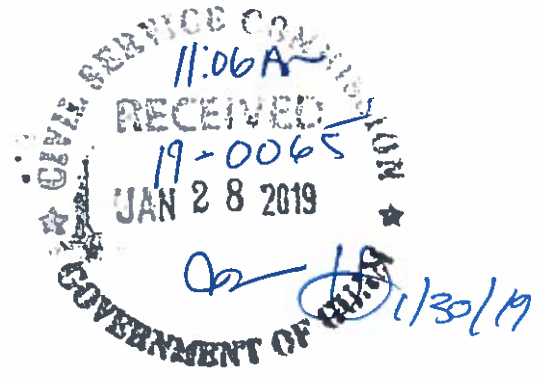

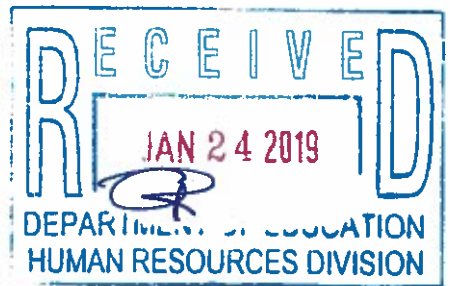
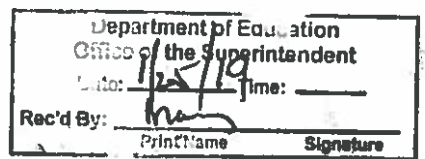
Dear Superintendent Fernandez,
