
6 The Employee post audit complaint of March 19, 2019 aforementioned, is hereby

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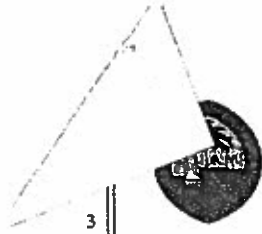
