

CSC RESOLUTION NO. 88-013

RELATIVE TO COMMENDING THE NINETEENTH GUAM LEGISLATURE FOR PASSING BILL NO. 105 PROVIDING FOR AN INDEPENDENT CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION:

WHEREAS, Bill No 105 providing for an independent Civil Service Commission was passed by the Nineteenth Guam Legislature on October 7, 1988; and

WHEREAS, Bill No. 105, if enacted, would result in a stronger and more effective Civil Service Commission and immensely improve the administration of the merit system; and

whereas, the Nineteenth Guam Legislature recognizes the importance of having an independent and effective Civil Service Commission in the administration of the merit system; and

WHEREAS, the Nineteenth Guam Legislature, in passing Bill No. 105, was responsive to the petition of over 1,000 GovGuam employees supporting an independent Civil Service Commission; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, the Civil Service Commission extends its appreciation and commends the Nineteenth Guam Legislature for its passing Bill No. 105 in support of the Civil Service Commission and the merit system; and be it further

RESOLVED, this Resolution be transmitted to the Speaker of the Nineteenth Guam Legislature.
