RESOLUTION NO. CSC NO. 99-012

RELATIVE TO THE AMENDMENT TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE FOR ADVERSE ACTIONS TO INCLUDE CSC RULE 800 E (1) (B) ON MOTIONS FOR "STAYS"

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has implemented Rules of Procedure for Adverse Actions, Rules Relative to Lay Representatives, and Rules for Motion Procedure; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission amends the Rules of Procedure for Adverse Actions to include CSC Rule 900 E (1) (b) on Motions for "Stays;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

that the Rules of Procedure for Adverse Actions is hereby amended to incorporate the following subsection of CSC Rule 800 E (1) (b) as follows:

"RULE 800 E: MOTIONS: (CONTINUED)

E (1) (b) STAYS:

The Commission's Administrative Counsel is empowered to grant "stays" of actions when a motion to stay proceedings is brought by Appellant on the basis that Appellant has been or may be charged with a criminal offense which arises from the same factual transaction which is the basis of the adverse or other action taken by Appellee".
