This matter came before the commission March 7, 2019. Present were Cynthia KM Camacho, Personnel Management Analyst II, and Roland P. Fejarang, Personnel Management Administrator. Mrs. Camacho read the staff assessment report.

By a vote of 5-0 the Commission voted to adopt the staff recommendation finding that the Civil Service Commission lacks subject matter jurisdiction considering that Mr. Diaz was not an employee of the Government of Guam at the time he gave his testimony to the Guam Legislature, the event for which he claims retaliation by the Department of Education.
