Also present was the employee, Michael Taijeron, Jr., appearing pro se; and Carla Borja, Deputy Director of the Department of Corrections, and her counsel, Assistant Attorney General David J. Highsmith. The parties announced on the record that they had resolved the case and put a stipulation to the following effect on the record:

**ORIGINAL**

1. The employee, Michael Luis Torres Tajeron, Jr., shall resign his position of employment at the Department Corrections as of the date that this Final Adverse Action became effective, namely, April 2, 2013.
2. The Department of Corrections shall expunge the employee's personnel file of all references to this Adverse Action and the facts and circumstances surrounding it.
3. There shall be no reinstatement, no award of back pay or attorney's fees, and no relief granted other than what is stated herein.
4. The employee's Appeal from the Adverse Action is hereby dismissed.
