1 Staff read the report into the record. Employee representative, Daniel Del
2 Priore, moved to continue the matter to allow the 6 police officers to be interviewed by
3 the Personnel Management Analyst. The Commission discussed the matter and
4 decided further interviews were unnecessary and voted 6-0 to follow the
5 recommendation of staff that GPD correctly hired the 6 USERRA employees to 1-Police
6 Lieutenant (Anthony T. Arriola), and 5-Police Officer IIs (Benjamin E. Cruz; Brian C.
7 Gumataotao; Rick Jason N. Lizama; Terrence T. Walker; Michael J. Winn; and, Jasen
8 Dodd). GPD will need to correct PO#18-022 from the retroactive effective date of July
9 31, 2018 to the proper retroactive date of August 17, 2017 for the Police Lieutenant, and
10 September 29, 2017 for the Police Officer IIs.
