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


1 Commission voted 3 to 2 in favor to null and void his personnel action. Having failed
2 to get the required 4 votes, the Personnel Action is affirmed as valid.

3 Chairman Calvo advised the Commission that the rule states a 180-day period
4 after the filing of the Complaint to null and void a personnel action. September 8, 2021
5 was the deadline. The deadline having passed the Commission had no jurisdiction to
6 null and void this personnel action. The Commission voted 5 to 0 to deny the Motion
7 to reconsider.


