ORDER

The above-captioned matter came before the Civil Service Commission (“CSC”) on September 26, 2024, for a Post Audit Investigative Hearing regarding Dennis Mendiola, et al (“Employee”) and Guam Solid Waste Authority (“GSWA”). The Decision and Judgment was signed on December 3, 2024.


A Motion to Reconsider was timely filed on December 5, 2024. Due to the holiday season and the lack of a quorum, the Civil Service Commission was unable to hear the Motion in accordance with the timeline prescribed by statute.

1 Adverse Action Rule 11.7.7 describes that reconsideration motions must be
2 filed with the CSC within 10 days and that a determination must be made “within
3 thirty days.”

4 The Commissioners did not deliberate on this issue.

5 The issue is defunct as the authority to take action has expired. The Civil
6 Service Commission hereby Orders that the above captioned case continues to be
7 dismissed, without alteration, pursuant to the signed Decision and Judgment dated
8 December 3, 2024.
