
1 Employee was present with her Lay Representative Robert Koss. Management
2 was present represented by Tom Baubata and Phyllis Blas.


3 Complainant alleges she was denied salary increments when she moved from
4 Guam Memorial Hospital to Department of Education.


5 Maria Masnayon, Personnel Management Analyst III, read the Assessment
