
**ORDER AFTER HEARING**


This matter came before the Civil Service Commission (CSC) for a Post Audit Assessment Hearing February 9, 2021. The Post Audit Assessment was presented by Maria Masnayan, Personnel Management Analyst III. Commissioners present were: Chairman Juan K. Calvo, Vice Chairman John A. Smith, Emilia Flores Rice, Anthony P. Benavente, and Robert Taitano.

1 The Chairman noted that in this matter, the Complainant, Glen Nelson  
2 filed a letter requesting to withdraw his complaint. The Commissioners discussed  
3 whether to dismiss the Post Audit per Complainant's request or proceed with the  
4 staff Assessment. The Chairman stated that the mission of the CSC is to  
5 investigate illegal personnel actions and argued that the CSC should proceed with  
6 an Assessment.


