Deborah Aflague Duenas ("Employee") was present and was represented by Attorney Joshua D. Walsh.

The Commission provided both parties an opportunity to present oral arguments, had an opportunity to question the attorneys on both sides of the argument, then considered Management's Motion to Dismiss Appeal.
