2 The jurisdiction of the Commission is based upon Title 4 Guam Code  
3 Annotated, §4401 et seq., and relevant portions of the Guam Power Authority  
4 Personnel Rules and Regulations.


5 **DISCUSSION**


6 Management moved to dismiss the Post Audit on the grounds that the


