The Jurisdiction of the Civil Service Commission is based upon the Organic Act of Guam, 4 GCA §§4401. et seq. and relevant Personnel Rules and Regulations.

After due deliberations, the Commissioners determined that the Employee was an Unclassified Employee on probationary status at the time of his dismissal. Therefore, by a vote of 5 to 0 the Commission had no jurisdiction to hear the Motion.

Due to the fact that the Commission lacks jurisdiction in cases of unclassified employees, this case is dismissed by a vote 5-0.
