DECISION AND JUDGMENT

This matter came on to heard before the Civil Service Commission (Commission) on September 6, 2022 for a Mini-Hatch Assessment Report Hearing. Employee was present. Present for Management was Phyllis Blas, lay representative for the Department of Education.

Commissioners present were Chairman Juan K. Calvo, Vice Chairman Anthony P. Benavente, Commissioner Priscilla T. Tuncap, Commissioner John Smith, and Commissioner Robert C. Taitano.

1 On August 12, 2022, Employee filed this complaint because she found
2 campaign material in the Agueda Johnston Middle School office, Department of
3 Education. These materials were delivered by the United States Postal Service
4 (USPS), not an employee of the Department of Education.

5 Cynthia Camacho read the Assessment Report into the record. Staff noted
6 that USPS are not subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission and recommended
7 not to proceed with an investigation.

8 The Commission voted 5 to 0 not to proceed with the investigation.


