4 Employees are Resource Officers of the Department of Education. Their
5 complaint is that they have been assigned to do support staff tasks which they deem
6 to be a *defacto* demotion. After the filing of the grievance, Superintendent Jon P.
7 Fernandez, Department of Education, signed a letter stating that Resource Officers
8 would no longer be assigned as school staff support.

9 The issue having become moot, and the Employees expressing no objection,
10 the Commission voted 5 to 0 to dismiss the grievance.


