
1 Employee Randy Diaz was present *pro se*. Present for Management, Guam
2 Memorial Hospital Authority (“GMHA”), were counsel Jordan Lawrence Pauluhn,
3 and Hospital Administrator Lillian Perez-Posadas.

4 At the beginning of the hearing, the parties indicated that a resolution had been
5 reached in the case and both parties desired to bring motions.

6 Employee moved, orally and in writing, to dismiss the adverse action with
7 prejudice. Management moved, orally and in writing, to void the adverse action at
8 issue in the case.

9 The Commissioners heard both motions. The Commission voted four (4) to
10 zero (0) to grant GMHA’s motion to void the adverse action. The Commission voted
11 four (4) to zero (0) to grant the motion to dismiss with prejudice.




