Taitano.

1 Maria Masnayan, Personnel Management Analyst III, read the Staff
2 Investigation Report. Staff made the following findings:

3 1. Mr. Hadap was not prevented from filing his complaint. His
4 supervisors did not know why Mr. Hadap left the Health and Wellness parking
5 lot training scene and had no knowledge he intended to file a complaint.

6 2. Mr. Hadap was provided the same information as other trainees.

7 3. Mr. Hadap was not singled out by his supervisor to be abused.


8 4. Mr. Hadap was terminated because he told his supervisor he wanted to
9 inflict "streetwise justice," and left the training site without permission.

11 The Commission voted 5 to 0 that no further action be taken on this Whistle
12 Blower Complaint.


