
1 Commissioners present were Chairman Juan K. Calvo, Commissioner
2 Priscilla T. Tuncap, Commissioner John Smith, Commissioner Robert C. Taitano,
3 and Commissioner Francisco T. Guerrero.

4 Management moved, among other things, for the Commission to require
5 the presence of Employee at the merit hearings. Administrative Counsel Eric D.
6 Miller advised the Commission that the Employee is required to by statute to be
7 physically present at all due process hearings. 5 GCA, §43121 (d).

8 The Commission voted 5 to 0 to deny Employee's Motion for the
9 Employee to be absent at the merit hearings.

10 The Commission also voted 5 to 0 to assign the other eight (8) motions to
11 Administrative Law Judge, Eric D. Miller, and to provide the Commission with
12 recommendations.
