Complainant was present with Lay Representative Robert Koss. Management was 2 represented by Phyllis Blas. Complainant was a transfer/promotion from Guam Memorial Hospital (GMH) to 3 Department of Education (DOE). In August of 2020, Complainant seeks to have her 4 increment date be the same as it was at GMH, not one year from the time she started 5 at DOE. Staff found that the personnel action was lawful. The timing of her annual 6 evaluation is not a personnel action.
